
## How to install Prestashop Module.

## Requirements.

- Prestashop installed
- PHP 7.0 or Higher


## How to install.

1. Download the module: First, you need to download the module you want to install. You can do this from the official PrestaShop Addons marketplace or from a third-party website.




2. Log in to your PrestaShop back office: Go to your PrestaShop website's backend and log in with your admin credentials.

3. Navigate to the "Modules" section: Once logged in, click on the "Modules" option in the menu on the left-hand side.



4. Click on the "Upload a module" button: This option is located in the top right-hand corner of the page.



5. Select the module file: Click on the "Choose File" button and select the module file that you downloaded earlier.




6. Install the module: Once the module has been uploaded, you will see an "Install" button. Click on it to install the module.



7. Configure the module: After the installation is complete, you can access the module's settings from the "Modules" section of the backend and configure it to suit your needs.

## How to configure.



- (1) Get your Instagram API Key, Click on the link (2) to view an easy guide on how to get it
- (3) Enable Cache so your instagram feed will update only every hours. Boost the performance of your website.
- (4) Where the module will be displayed
- (5) Navigation types:
  - None: Only drag and drop
  - o Arrows on both side
  - Pagination on the bottom
  - o Both of them
- (6) Style of the slider, just play around to find the style that fits you
- (7) How round the slider will be
- (8) Does the slider needs to be fullwidth or fit your main container
- (9) Color of the navigation (Arrows and pagination)
- (10) Save every field above
- (11) Remove the cached feed then refetch it
- (12) Remove all the fields, be careful it will remove your API key
